Dr. Prabha Mandayam is an associate professor in the department of Physics at the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras. Prior to this, she was an Inspire faculty fellow at the Chennai Mathematical Institute and a Post-doctoral Fellow with the Optics and Quantum Information Group at the Institute of Mathematical Sciences. She obtained her PhD in Physics from the Institute for Quantum Information and Matter at Caltech. Her research interests are broadly in the area of quantum computing and quantum information theory, and in particular in quantum error correction, and understanding the interplay between quantum foundations and quantum cryptography, and using quantum information as a tool to explore fundamental questions in theoretical physics.
