

Songi Han is a Physical Chemist and Professor in the Department of Chemistry at Northwestern University (NU) and is also affiliated with NU's Applied Physics Program. She joined NU in July 2023 after a 20-year career as a Professor in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at UC Santa Barbara. Her research considers electron and nuclear spins as probes, amplifiers, sensors and detectors. She is on the Executive Committee of the International EPR Society since 2020, on the Executive Council of the International Society of Magnetic Resonance (ISMAR) and the inaugural chair of a new Gordon Research Conference on Magnetic Resonance and Quantum Information Science in 2026.
