Prof. Sunil Nair is a faculty member at the Department of Physics, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Pune. He did his PhD at the Inter University Consortium for DAE Facilities, Indore, followed by post-doctoral stints at the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Mumbai, the Max Planck Institute for Chemical Physics of Solids at Dresden, Germany, and the University of Oxford. His research interests lie in the area of Quantum Materials, with special focus on spin electronics, and the magnetic, electronic and thermodynamic properties of strongly correlated quantum matter. He currently serves as the Project Director of I-Hub Quantum Technology Foundation at IISER Pune, and was instrumental in executing the first Call for Proposals to fund start-ups under the National Quantum Mission.
